## Subject: Fee structure for VAC, AEC, MDC and SEC courses for the first year

Dear Madam /Sir,

In response to the number of queries received from affiliated Colleges, the following fee structure is recommended after discussion with the DHE officials and with the approval of the University Authority:
I. 2 Value Added Courses (VAC-1 \& VAC-2) ; One is Environmental studies whose fees is already included in the fee structure of a Department/College/Institute. VAC is 2 credit course i.e. 2 hours of teaching per week
Fees recommended $=30 \times 6=$ Rs. 180 p.a.
II. 2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC-1 \& SEC-2); One of these is SEC-1 which is a computer course whose fees is already included in the fee structure of a Department/College/Institute . SEC is 3 credit course i.e. 4 hours of teaching per week Fees recommended $=37.5 \times 6=$ Rs. 225 p.a.
III. 2 Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC-1 \& AEC-2);

AEC is 2 credit language course i.e. 2 hours of teaching per week and will be taught by the existing Hindi/English/Punjabi/Sanskrit teacher and hence no additional fees is recommended.
IV. 2 Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC-1 \& MDC-2); MDC is 3 credit course. Fee structure for MDC is recommended as under :
For subjects Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Zoology, Geology, Electronics

Alternatively in general, all other college may charge Rs. 750 p.a. uniformly from students of first year of all the streams.

This fees is recommended for additional VAC, AEC, MDC and SEC courses only of first year under NEP-2020 scheme w.e.f. 2023-24 and the College / Institute may charge this fee as per its additional requirement of resources for $\mathrm{VAC}, \mathrm{AEC}, \mathrm{MDC}$ and SEC courses.
